## Director Alê Abreu

Ale Abreu was born in São Paulo in March 6, 1971. At the age of 13 he signed in the workshop of animation of the Brazilian Museum of Image and Sound, where he made his first short, entitled "Elephant Memory". Graduated in Social Communication, he made the shorts; "Sirius" (1993), and "Scarecrow" (1998). Ale developed several works for advertising as the award-winning Nestle's Milk Bottles, and many illustrations for magazines, newspapers and books. In 2008 he realesed in theaters and on DVD, the feature animation "Cosmic Boy ", with a book adaptation by FTD publisher. His last film, the short "Step" (2007), participated in the most important animation festivals in the world. Currently he works illustrating books, developing an animated series and promoting his latest feature film, "The Boy and the World".

## Director's Statement

THE BOY AND THE WORLD started without a script, already in an Animatic (a filmed story board), while I was searching for clues, bits of stories and music that we've been experimenting with. I believe that a difficult childhood, the absence of a father, symbolically take us back to the History of the Latin American countries. The film's message came up without words, without a written screenplay, in a very intuitive process, like a painting filling a canvas. There was a desire to express something I couldn't put into words, and maybe I cannot until this day, but it came true through audiovisual language, through drawings, sounds and animation. I believe people feel very touched by the film, as much as we have felt making it. Tarkovsky said that cinema fills in our spiritual wholes, I believe that too, and I feel my work is oriented on that way.
